

VAN BUREN ASSN. HELD FINAL MEETING OF '42

**Sale of Andrews Holdings to
Management Corporation
Was Announced.**

The last meeting of the year of the Van Buren Point association was held Saturday, Sept. 5, at the district schoolhouse in Van Buren road. There was a large attendance of cottage owners.

The president, W. J. Bragdon, in his annual report, explained that W. D. Andrews, who is leaving for the service, has sold out his land rights to a group of men, forming a corporation. This will be called the Van Buren Point Management corporation.

Also mentioned by the president was the improvement in the traffic and safety of the colony during the past summer season. Much credit was given to Earl Zimmer, deputy sheriff.

The president then expressed the appreciation of the people of the Point for the cooperation of the town board of Portland.
